evening events during the spring/summer season, although opening hours are often

Group booking discounts apply only to groups of 10 or larger.

We do understand that sometimes due to matters beyond your control numbers may fall below 10; however we reserve the right to charge for 10 people should a guided tour be booked, or to charge the standard rates for unguided access. No special offers or other discounted entry rates will apply in conjunction with any group visit discount.

We kindly ask that you arrive promptly if a guided tour is booked to avoid delays for other groups later in the day. Should your group arrive late, you may forfeit your allocated tour timeslot. In this case your group will be asked to wait until a convenient time later in the day.

HEALTH & SAFETY GUIDELINES FOR GARDEN VISITORS

Please wear suitable clothing and footwear (i.e. boots) for your trip around the garden which will extend to around 1½ miles and involve some steep slopes if you opt for the longest routes.

Slipping and tripping hazards are very real in a woodland garden like

Caerhays especially after spring gales and heavy rain. Please therefore stick

to the paths at all times and proceed with particular care when conditions are

wet underfoot.

The garden does contain hidden hazards especially for children (e.g. steep slopes and quarries) and it is therefore essential that children are accompanied at all times.

Those with disabilities should seek more detailed help and advice on arrival.

Whilst Caerhays Estate has taken reasonable measures to eliminate risks

for visitors it is not possible to remove every conceivable risk in a woodland

garden of this sort. The responsibility for the safety of visitors should

therefore be seen to be shared between visitors and the Estate.

During adverse weather conditions the gardens may be closed for safety reasons. Details will appear on the notice board near the beach or please phone the office on 01872 501310 for up to date information.

Well behaved dogs are welcome in the gardens and on the beach only. All dogs must be on leads. We regret that dogs are not allowed in the castle.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR COACH DRIVERS

Due to our rural and secluded location, the journey to Caerhays can be difficult if you have never visited us before. Your journey will involve narrow country lanes and tight bends, as well as a lack of adequate satellite navigation information. (Please advise your coach driver not to use Satnav as it will take you on roads unsuitable for coaches).

For coach directions please ensure that your driver views our website, at https://visit.caerhays.co.uk/visit-us/directions/access-by-coach/ and make sure that they are aware that parts of the journey will be narrow with sharp bends.

We strongly advise that you ask your driver to call the estate office prior to your journey for further information. Caerhays Estate Office: (01872) 501 310

The narrow Cornish lanes around Caerhays mean that coach drivers need to plan their route carefully. The straightest and best route from the main A390 is marked in purple on the map. (This map can be viewed more clearly on our website).

Coaches may come up to the disabled parking area (beside the castle courtyard) to drop off passengers. Please note that our disabled parking area is of limited size and for health and safety reasons we politely ask that your driver park the coach down at the main car park (Porthluney Beach) Please note the coach will enter via the emergency access gates on arrival. We also recommend allowing 10 minutes to return to the coach from the shop/exit at the end of your visit.
